## E-Verify Notes for Employers

- Enroll in E-Verify by January 1, 2012 and verify all new hires. Do not E-Verify employees already on the payroll prior to enrollment.
- Do not use E-Verify to pre-screen employment applicants
- Do not influence or coerce an employee's decision whether to contest a tentative nonconfirmation
- Do not terminate or take adverse action against an employee who is contesting a tentative nonconfirmation
- Do not ask an employee to provide additional documentation of his/her employment eligibility after obtaining a tentative nonconfirmation for that employee
- Do not request specific documents in order to activate E-Verify photo matching
