

Central Carolina Technical College (CCTC) is the designated technical college for the Environmental Engineering Technology program. CCTC is now offering a college certificate program for water and wastewater operators. Each certificate has six (6) college credit courses (for a total of 18 hours) that can be completed in one-year. The program is offered online and may be completed from your personal computer. The South Carolina Environmental Certification Board has approved this certificate to count as one-year of work experience toward an operator's license.

Here are some benefits to this program:

- The certificate is substituted for 1 year of work experience through LLR; for example a trainee can become a "C" operator after one year of actual operating experience and passing the D and C exam
- All classes are **online**
- Lottery, Pell Grant, and GI Bill money are available for qualifying students
- Ask your employer about tuition reimbursement
- All of the courses are transferable into the Environmental Engineering Technology Associate Degree program at CCTC
