

LLR EXTENDING DEADLINE TO SUBMIT 2025 SAFETY AWARD APPLICATIONS

Columbia, South Carolina – The South Carolina Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation is extending the deadline for employers to participate in the 2025 Safety Awards program. Applications can now be submitted by 11:59 p.m. on May 2, 2025.

The program recognizes companies' efforts to reduce recordable occupational injuries and illnesses during the past year. The program is open to any qualifying South Carolina employer, whether large or small, public or private. Awards are presented in three categories:

	<u>Private sector</u>	<u>Public Sector</u>
Palmetto Shining Star	 No fatalities or recordable injuries or illnesses during calendar year 2024; A reduction of at least 40 percent in an employer's incidence rate between 2023 and 2024; A difference of at least 75 percent in an employer's 2024 incidence rate and the 2023 South Carolina average rate for that industry; OR Worked one million or more safe work hours without a lost-time injury or illness in 2024 	 No fatalities or recordables during calendar year 2024 (TC = 0); A reduction of at least 20 percent in an employer's incidence rate between 2023 and 2024; OR A difference of at least 50 percent in an employer's 2024 incidence rate and the 2023 South Carolina average rate for the applicable State or Local government NAICS
Rising Star	A difference of at least 75 percent in an employer's 2024 incidence rate and the 2023 <u>national</u> average rate for that industry	A difference of at least 50 percent in an employer's 2024 incidence rate and the 2023 <u>national</u> average rate for the applicable State or Local government NAICS
Gleaming Star	Fewer than 100 employees and demonstrates a culture of safety and health both on site and in the community	Fewer than 100 employees and demonstrates a culture of safety and health both on site and in the community
