



On October 5, 2018, the South Carolina Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board will implement a new Reseller Examination. Each exam form will be comprised of 50 multiple choice questions, and require a passing score 70%. The Board will make changes to the Dealer/Installer Examination at a later date. It is recommended that the following documents be used in preparation for the Reseller Examination:

The above referenced materials are also available on the Board's website. Examinations are open book, but only items 1-4 listed above will be permitted. The materials must be free of writing/notes and no sharing of materials is allowed during the examinations. Board staff will inspect materials prior to administering the examination to ensure compliance.

Examinations are typically administered the first and third Friday of each month (excluding state holidays) at the Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation, 110 Centerview Drive, Columbia, SC 29210. An examination schedule is located on the [Board's website](#). Testing begins promptly at 10am and ends at noon. Participants must be on time (the Board recommends arriving 15 minutes early) and bring state-issued photo identification. In addition, cell phones and other electronic media are not permitted at the test site.
