Chairman Grimball called the meeting to order at 10:10 A.M.

MOTION: Motion to approve the minutes of the May 6, 2009 meeting as read was made by John Tarkany. Morgan Grimball seconded the motion. Council unanimously concurred.

1. Ms. Moorer told council she has received several inquiries regarding how “other qualifying experience” is reviewed by council. She suggested that council stay alert to this issue and let her know if they get any questions regarding how education and experience are reviewed for LARE and registration eligibility.

New Business

1. Ms. Moorer told council that CLARB has redesigned their website. Each state board has a profile, and all of the council members have been added to it and have access to portions of the Board Members section. Many functions are now available on-line such as: Downloading CLARB Council Records, ordering the graphics sections of the LARE, checking participation credits and balances from annual dues, and signing up for regional and national meetings. The new website also has increased security for candidates applying for the C/LARE.
2. Ms. Moorer told council that Steve McCalla is no longer able to print certificates for landscape architects. The SC Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism shut down their graphics section early this year. She has also been unable to find a vendor that can provide the large certificates they have been using since 2000. She contacted LLR and got the template for the Architecture and Engineering Certificates so new registrants can have a certificate provided to them in a timely manner. Council agreed that their certificates should stand out from the certificates for other professions. Something that resembles the old design would be more

appropriate for this program. Mr. McLeod suggested changes to the font and bold lettering to make the state and profession name stand out. Mr. Anderson suggested highlighting the license number as well. Mr. McLeod and Mr. Tarkany provided digital signatures for the new certificates. Mr. Anderson said he would E-mail Ms. Moorer a copy of his certificate so she could work with the DNR Graphic Section to produce a new certificate.
