- CTE is a brain disease that could impair brain 01 function, negatively affecting memory, thinking, emotions and movement.
- Symptoms of CTE can begin years after receiving 02 repetitive hits to the head.
- More frequent hits over a longer period of time may 03 increase your risk for CTE.
- Scientists are still learning about CTE but think there may be other risk factors for CTE including genetics and **04** drug/alcohol use.
- Repetitive hits to the head, even when they don't 05 cause a concussion, are a risk factor for developing CTE.
- CTE currently can only be diagnosed after death by 06 looking at the brain under a microscope.
