2025-2027 AUCTIONEER RENEWAL APPLICATION

Renewal Instructions/Requirements:

- Biennial renewal fee of \$300 in the form of a check or money order only (no cash) made payable to Auctioneers' Commission. (All fees are non-refundable. A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds.)
- Your renewal must be postmarked on or before June 30, 2025, to avoid late fees.
- Biennial Renewal / Late Fees:

Renewed/postmarked on or before 6/30/2025: \$300

Renewed/postmarked 7/1/2025 - 7/31/2025: Late Fee \$25 + Renewal Fee \$300 = \$325

Renewed/postmarked 8/1/2025 - 9/30/2025: Late Fee \$100 + Renewal Fee \$300 = \$400

After September 30, 2025, your license is lapsed. Any licensee in lapse status must make application for a new auctioneer license and must be in accordance with §40-6-230.
