## 2022 Legislative Update Board of Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology

The following bill was enacted by the General Assembly during the 2022 legislative session and impacts the Board of Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology and/or the Board of Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology licensees:

## Audiology Speech-Language Pathologist Compact (ASLP Compact), H.3840/Act 160

H.3840 enters South Carolina into the Audiology Speech-Language Pathologist Licensure Compact (ASLP Compact) by adding Sections 40-67-500 to 40-67-640 to the speech-language pathology practice act to authorize an audiologist or speech-language pathologist licensed by a home state to be recognized by each member state under a privilege to practice in each member state. To obtain a compact privilege, a licensee must meet the statutory requirements, and satisfy the state and national fingerprint criminal background check requirements.
