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PHARMACIST REACTIVATION OF INACTIVE LICENSE INSTRUCTIONS

Reactivation of an inactive license:

Section 40-43-110 (C)

A pharmacist who wishes to renew his license in an inactive status must submit a renewal application to the board. If mailed, the board must receive the application before April first, including all required fees and data; however, no continuing education is required. If not postmarked before April first a penalty of fifty dollars must be assessed. The license certificate must be prominently marked as an inactive license, and the holder may not practice pharmacy under any conditions in this or any state based on the South Carolina license. If the pharmacist wishes to reactivate the license, he shall complete the required continuing education for license renewal, plus an additional fifteen hours which must have been obtained during the calendar year immediately preceding the date of the reactivation application.

To reactive your inactive license, submit the following:

- A written request to place your license in Active status
- Thirty (30) CE hours
