Community Residential Care Facilities (CRCFs) and Assisted Living Homes provide room and board and a degree of personal assistance. The core services provided include, but are not limited to:

- Three meals a day
- · Snacks at no additional charge
- · Housekeeping services
- · Assistance with eating, bathing, dressing, toileting, and walking
- · Medication assistance
- 24 hours, seven days a week staffing
- Transportation to medical appointments

As a CRCF resident you have the right to be treated with dignity and respect, to have freedom of choice, and a physical environment that is safe, secure, sanitary and well-maintained.
