Renewal Tips

- 1. **Renew early and renew online.** Once you have completed all required CME, log into the LLR Online Services Portal to renew. Late renewals cannot be done online. If you are renewing late, you must submit a paper application.
- 2. **Know your Online Portal User ID and Password.** Your User ID and Password must be used to access your online account. If you forget your login information please follow the below steps:
 - a. If you have a valid email address on file with the Board go to https://eservice.llr.sc.gov/OnlineRenewals/ and click on "I Forgot/Do Not know my User ID and/or I Forgot My Password."
 - b. If you do NOT have a valid email address on file with the Board please email the Board at medboard@llr.sc.gov and provide your name, license number, last 5 digits of your social security number, and current email address. Once your email is updated, a password reset will be sent via email.
- 3. **Keep up to date on news from the Board.** During the renewal period, the Board will send out updates via email and website postings. News posted on the website can be found at www.llr.sc.gov/med under "Board News."
- 4. **Pay by proxy.** You can designate a proxy payer for renewal. This information will come up as an option under *Online Services* during your renewal.

Continuing Medical Education (CME)

- 1. Submitting Proof of CME:
 - a. Renewing On-Time: MD/DO, RCP, AND PA Licensees are NOT required to send actual CME certificates, transcripts etc. to the board office when renewing on time. Keep them for your records, or use *CE Broker* to track your CME history, in case of a board CME audit. https://www.cebroker.com/sc/account/basic ce broker
 - b. **Late Renewals:** Physicians renewing late must submit proof of CME to the Board. Proof must include course provider, course title, date of activity, category I AMA/AOA approved, number of hours earned, and recipient's name.
- 2. **First renewal after receiving a permanent license** With the exception of Podiatry, licensees in their first renewal cycle are not required to complete CME.

- 3. **CME Date Range** CME must be completed during the 24-month period preceding the renewal deadline date for your license and **before** you renew online.
- 4. Partial CME Credit for Volunteer Service Physicians may claim up to 10 hours for volunteer medical services. SC Code SECTION 38-79-30(B) Any licensed health care provider who renders medical services voluntarily and without compensation or the expectation or promise of compensation and seeks no reimbursement from charitable and governmental sources may fulfill one hour of continuing education for each hour of volunteer medical services rendered, up to a maximum of twenty-five percent of the provider's required continuing education credits for the licensure period.
 - a. An "Emergency" license will **NOT** qualify you for volunteer hours/services. These are paid positions. If you would like to use hours from volunteer medical services, you will need to submit a letter from the organization you volunteered with for review and approval.

Active Duty Military

Active duty military personnel seeking the fee or CME exemption cannot renew online. Please contact the Board for a paper application.

SECTION 40-1-610. Continuing education exemption.

A person whose profession or occupation is regulated by this title is exempt from completing continuing education requirements for his profession or occupation while serving on active military duty

SECTION 40-1-620. License fee exemption.

A person whose profession or occupation is regulated by this title may not be assessed, and is exempt from being required to pay, a license fee for his profession or occupation for a calendar year in which he serves any period of active military duty.

Must complete forty (40) total hours of Category 1 AMA/AOA CME to renew your license. 30 hours in your Specialty; 8 hours may be Non-Specialty; 2 hours must be in Safe Prescribing and Monitoring of Controlled Substances. These two (2) hours are required every two years <u>regardless of your specialty or whether you actually prescribe controlled substances.</u>
