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Pharmacotherapeutics Education Required for Prescriptive Authority

2. Required Documents

Certificate of attendance that includes:

- 1. Name of licensee
- 2. Title and Date of educational activity
- 3. Approving provider/ organization name, course number and address
- 4. Number of *pharmacotherapeutics contact hours* awarded

3. Conversion Formulas

The following formulas may be used to convert continuing education credit.

- 1 contact hour = 60 minutes
- 1 CME = 60 minutes or 1.0 contact hours
- 1 contact hour = 0.1 CEU
- 1 CEU = 10 contact hours
