To be exempt from having to take an English language proficiency examination, you must meet BOTH of the following requirements:

- 1. English must have been the language of instruction, including the language of the textbooks.
- 2. Your entry level nursing education was completed in one of the following countries:
 - Australia
 - Barbados
 - Ireland
 - Jamaica
 - New Zealand
 - Canada (except Quebec, the only schools approved for exemption are: McGill University, Dawson College, Vanier College, John Abbott College, and Heritage College)

If you meet these criteria, you do not need to take an English language proficiency examination.
