CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Stephen V. Corey, of Kingtree, Chairman of the Board, called the regular meeting of the South Carolina Board of Podiatry Examiners to order at 4:05 p.m. on Monday, December 7, 2015, at 110 Centerview Drive, with a quorum present. Other members of the Board present included Dr. James B. Cahill, of Sumter, Dr. Paul J. Shromoff, of Goose Creek; and Dr. Brandon S. Percival, of Lancaster.

Members of the staff participating at various times in the meeting included Mr. Sheridan Spoon, Administrator; Mrs. Darra Coleman, and Mr. Adam Russell, Office of Advice Counsel; and Mrs. Candace Gunter, Administrative Assistant. Ms. Althea Myers, Ms. Ashley Bailey, and Mr. Byron Ray, Office of Investigations and Enforcement were in attendance. Ms. Shanika Johnson, Office of Disciplinary Counsel was also present. Ms. Tina Beyles, Capital City Reporting.

All votes by the Board reported in these minutes were unanimous unless otherwise indicated.

Dr. Corey announced that the meeting was being held in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act by notice to *The State* newspaper, Associated Press, and notices posted on the bulletin boards located at both the main entrances of the Kingtree Building where the Board office is located.

REVIEW OF AGENDA AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The agenda for this meeting was reviewed and approved. Dr. Percival made a motion to approve the Agenda that was seconded by Dr. Cahill and unanimously passed. The Board reviewed the minutes from the June 8, 2015 meeting. Dr. Shromoff made a motion that was seconded by Dr. Cahill and unanimously passed to approve the minutes without changes. Motion carries. INVESTIGATIVE REVIEW COMMITTEE REPORT

Ms. Althea Myers, Chief Investigator presented an IRC report submitting 3 cases for approval to include 2 for dismissal and 1 letter of caution. Case #2 2015-2 represented by Ms. Ashley Bailey, Investigator III who states the patient's mother became irate with the medical staff when the patient was told she would not be a good candidate for surgery due to poor health concerns. Dr. Percival made a motion to approve the dismissal of Case #2014-6 and Case #2015-2 that was seconded by Dr. Shromoff. Motion passed by Dr. Corey. Case #2015-3, Dr. Shromoff made a motion to accept the Letter of Caution and seconded by Dr. Percival. Motion passed by Dr. Corey.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

A brief discussion was held by Mr. Sheridan Spoon concerning building security measures with the issuance of new badges, utilization of the tablets, and travel documentation.

REVIEW OF 2016 COMMITTEE MEETING DATES

Dr. Percival made the motion to accept the future dates of June 6, 2016 and December 5, 2016. Dr. Shromoff seconded and the motion carried.
