CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Stephen V. Corey, of Kingstree, Chairman of the Board, called the regular meeting of the South Carolina Board of Podiatry Examiners to order at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, June 2, 2014, at 110 Centerview Drive, with a quorum present. Other members of the Board present included Dr. James B. Cahill, of Sumter, Dr. Paul J. Shromoff, of Goose Creek; and Dr. Brandon S. Percival, of Lancaster.

Members of the staff participating at various times in the meeting included Sheridan Spoon, Advice Counsel; April Koon, Administrative Coordinator; Laura McDaniels, Administrative Assistant.

All votes by the Board reported in these minutes were unanimous unless otherwise indicated.

Dr. Corey announced that the meeting was being held in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act by notice to *The State* newspaper, Associated Press, and notices posted on the bulletin boards located at both the main entrances of the Kingstree Building where the Board office is located.

REVIEW OF AGENDA AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The agenda for this meeting was reviewed and approved. The Board reviewed the minutes from the December 9, 2013 meeting. Dr. Percival made a motion that was seconded by Dr. Cahill and unanimously passed to approve the minutes without changes. Motion carries.

The Board was asked to recommend IRC members that would be interested in serving on the committee. The board named Ron Ravenel, POD and William Harris IV, POD as possible licensees of interest to serve on the committee.
