CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Stephen V. Corey, of Kingtree, Chairman of the Board, called the regular meeting of the South Carolina Board of Podiatry Examiners to order at 3:45 p.m. on Monday, June 8, 2015, at 110 Centerview Drive, with a quorum present. Other members of the Board present included Dr. James B. Cahill, of Sumter, Dr. Paul J. Shromoff, of Goose Creek; and Dr. Brandon S. Percival, of Lancaster.

Members of the staff participating at various times in the meeting included Mr. Sheridan Spoon, Administrator; Mr. Alex Imgrund, Office of Advice Counsel; and Ms. Laura McDaniels, Administrative Assistant.

All votes by the Board reported in these minutes were unanimous unless otherwise indicated.

Dr. Corey announced that the meeting was being held in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act by notice to *The State* newspaper, Associated Press, and notices posted on the bulletin boards located at both the main entrances of the Kingtree Building where the Board office is located.

REVIEW OF AGENDA AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The agenda for this meeting was reviewed and approved. Dr. Percival made a motion to approve the Agenda that was seconded by Dr. Cahill and unanimously passed. The Board reviewed the minutes from the December 1, 2014 meeting. Dr. Shromoff made a motion that was seconded by Dr. Cahill and unanimously passed to approve the minutes without changes. The Recovering Professional Program was represented by Susan Coggins and Frank Sheheen. Dr. Percival made a motion to move into Executive Session that was seconded by Dr. Shromoff and unanimously passed. Dr. Cahill made a motion to move out of Executive Session that was seconded by Dr. Shromoff and unanimously passed. Dr. Percival made a motion to accept the MOA as presented with a private reprimand with recommendation that there is continuous enrollment and compliance with SCRPP. Upon completion of RPP, respondent can petition the Board for release of the Order. Motion carries.
