Permitted to Sell to Consumers in SC

- Purchased from a wholesaler licensed in South Carolina
- Contains required CPSC warning labels (ex: Warning, Caution, Danger)
- Consumer fireworks labeled 1.4G
- Has a safety fuse that provides between three (3) and nine (9) second delays
- Marked with UN0336 or UN0337 and an EX or FC number
- Cake fireworks with less than 500 grams of product

Prohibited to Sell to Consumers in SC

- All fireworks labeled 1.3G
- Pro fireworks labeled 1.4G
- Fireworks labeled "For Professional Use Only"
- Fireworks with Electric "Quick Match" fuses
- Fireworks labelled "Articles Pyrotechnic"
- Cake fireworks with more than 500 grams of product
- Small Bottle Rockets
- M-80s, Cherry Bombs
- Homemade Fireworks

Retailers should only be selling fireworks that are properly labeled, tested and certified. All consumer fireworks offered for sale must comply with all applicable federal and state safety standards listed below:

- SC State Law 40-56-1
- CPSC 16 C.F.R. § Part 1500 Hazardous Substances Regulations
- CPSC 16 C.F.R. § Part 1507 Fireworks Device Requirements
- APA Standard 87-1 American Pyrotechnics Association Consumer Fireworks Standards
- U.S. Department of Transportation 49 C.F.R. § 172.101
