Request for Continuing Education Exemption

Exemptions are not effective until you receive confirmation from the Commission office.

To qualify for Full CE Exemption, in accordance with SC Code Ann. § 40-57-340(B)(1)(d) a licensee must meet the following criteria:

- Twenty-five (25) years or more of licensure in South Carolina.
- Age sixty-five (65) or more (*submit a copy of state/federal ID with date of birth with form*).

To qualify for Partial CE Exemption*, in accordance with SC Code Ann. § 40-57-340(B)(1)(e) a licensee must meet the following criteria:

- Minimum of twenty-five (25) years of licensure in South Carolina.
*Licensees granted partial exemption are required to complete the mandatory four (4) hour core course. A Broker-in-Charge with a partial exemption are required to complete the mandatory four (4) hour core course and four (4) hour BIC Duties and Responsibilities course and is only exempt from two (2) elective hours.
