

**IMPORTANT: SCREC EDUCATION PROVIDERS AND COURSE DELIVERY
(2022 Update)**

Dear Current Licensed South Carolina Real Estate Providers and Instructors:

The South Carolina Real Estate Commission's (SCREC) temporary waiver of the ARELLO/ IDECC certification requirements for synchronous virtual offering of **approved** classroom courses has expired and cannot be renewed due to expiration of an executive order allowing licensing boards to temporarily waive regulations. The SC Real Estate licensing law requires the certification for all distance offerings.

Providers who are approved to administer a course only via classroom education can obtain the IDECC synchronous course certifications for any live instruction courses they wish to continue to administer online. These certifications may be submitted to the SC Real Estate Commission's education staff to update your course approval records.

The Commission approved waiver of the in-person final exam proctoring requirement for distance pre-licensing courses is extended until **December 31, 2022**, due to the regulation allowing the Commission to modify the pre-licensing course examination requirement as necessary. This will allow for virtual proctoring of the final examinations required for pre-licensing course completion.
